

# An Example of a Properly Formatted Submission to DoKDoK 2023

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**INTRODUCTION.** This template must be used for the preparation of the contribution for DoKDoK 2023. All accepted submissions will be published in the conference proceedings and will also appear on the website of the conference.

As opposed to conventional conferences, the purpose of the submission to DoKDoK is to give the reader a brief and lucid introduction to your topic. Bear in mind that most of the readers, who comprise mainly of doctoral students or beginners in optics, may not be specialists in your research topic or field.

**FORMATTING.** All submissions must fit on one page and must strictly adhere to the format of this template. Do not change the settings of the template, e.g., to fit more content on one page.

Manuscripts are not copy-edited and must be, therefore, provided in a publication-ready version by the authors. We ask you to provide the original files (Latex or Word) and a PDF. Necessary details of the preparation procedure are described below.

**Fonts.** Palatino is used for typesetting the main text and Cambria Math for the equations. The sans-serif font is Calibri. The LaTeX templates uses these fonts if they are installed on your system or falls back to similar fonts.

**Equations.** Use boldface symbols to denote vectorial quantities.

$$\nabla \times \mathbf{B} = \mu_0 \left( \mathbf{J} + \varepsilon_0 \frac{\partial \mathbf{E}}{\partial t} \right) \quad (1)$$

Non-inline equations are numbered in parentheses and referred to accordingly. An example is given in Eq. (1).

**Figures.** Figures should be embedded in the document and labeled Fig. 1, Fig. 2, and so on. Subfigures use alphabetic lettering i.e. Fig. 1 (a). Provide a concise caption that describes the figure. It is sufficient to provide a full explanation in the main text only.

All the figures will appear in color in print and online. Please note that raster images should have a resolution of at least 300 dpi to ensure good printing quality. The labels in the figure cannot be smaller than 6 pt in the final submission. We reserve the right to ask the author for post-corrections.

**References.** References should be numbered in square brackets in order of appearance in the text [1]. An appropriate list of references should appear at the end of the paper. An example of proper formatting is given at the end of this sample manuscript, see [2–7].

**EXPERIMENTAL SETUP.** The deadline for submitting your abstract is 19<sup>th</sup> of June! The registration deadline is 7<sup>th</sup> July! In next following weeks, you will receive the acceptance notification for both, the oral presentation or poster presentation category. And finally, on 28<sup>th</sup> August we will be happy to welcome you at Erfurt main station from where a bus will bring us to the “Waldhotel Berghof” in Luisenthal.
